

## WEEKLY ATHLETICS SPOTLIGHT BY RANGER SPORTS INFORMATION DIRECTOR, DEAN MASON

RANGER COLLEGE CAME OUT ON TOP IN A GAME AGAINST TEMPLE COLLEGE ON JANUARY 17, 2024, WITH A FINAL SCORE OF 76-66. THE GAME WAS PLAYED AT TEMPLE COLLEGE AT 7:00 PM.

THE FIRST HALF OF THE GAME SAW RANGER COLLEGE TAKE A COMMANDING LEAD, WITH A SCORE OF 42-27. HOWEVER, TEMPLE COLLEGE FOUGHT BACK IN THE SECOND HALF, OUTSCORING RANGER COLLEGE 39-34. DESPITE TEMPLE COLLEGE'S EFFORTS, RANGER COLLEGE HELD ONTO ITS LEAD, SECURING THE VICTORY.

KEY PLAYERS FOR RANGER COLLEGE INCLUDED ANDREW HOLIFIELD, WHO SCORED 21 POINTS, AND ASJON ANDERSON, WHO CONTRIBUTED 15 POINTS. SHARROD TAYLOR ALSO HAD A STRONG PERFORMANCE, SCORING 14 POINTS AND GRABBING 8 REBOUNDS.

FOR TEMPLE COLLEGE, THEO GRANT AND CALEB GASTON LED THE TEAM WITH 15 POINTS EACH. JACOB TAITTE ALSO HAD A NOTABLE PERFORMANCE, SCORING 14 POINTS AND GRABBING 5 REBOUNDS.

REGARDING TEAM STATISTICS, RANGER COLLEGE SHOT 44.9% FROM THE FIELD, WHILE TEMPLE COLLEGE SHOT 40.9%. RANGER COLLEGE ALSO HAD A HIGHER THREE-POINT SHOOTING PERCENTAGE, MAKING 27.8% OF THEIR ATTEMPTS COMPARED TO TEMPLE COLLEGE'S 14.8%. HOWEVER, TEMPLE COLLEGE HAD A BETTER FREE THROW SHOOTING PERCENTAGE, MAKING 66.7% OF THEIR ATTEMPTS COMPARED TO RANGER COLLEGE'S 56.3%.

OVERALL, RANGER COLLEGE'S STRONG PERFORMANCE IN THE FIRST HALF AND THEIR ABILITY TO MAINTAIN THEIR LEAD IN THE SECOND HALF LED TO THEIR VICTORY OVER TEMPLE COLLEGE. BOTH TEAMS PUT UP A GOOD FIGHT, BUT RANGER COLLEGE ULTIMATELY CAME OUT ON TOP. RANGER'S NEXT GAME IS IN WEATHERFORD ON JANUARY 24 AT 7:00 P.M.
