Guilty pleasure: Sometimes I play golf. Playing golf is time-consuming sports. When I play a golf game, I feel sorry to my wife.


Favorite Ranger College Moment: The most favorite Ranger College moment was when Ranger College offered a full-time job to me. It was a great moment in entire my life.
